For the Grand Canyon 16 and 18 foot boats with coolers 120 quarts or larger are best. People are often surprised by the magnificent size of a Grand Canyon foodpack! An average PRO Pack for 16 people and 16 day requires fou 18' PRO boats. An average Combo Pack requires five 18' PRO boats. Each PRO boat has a cooler, dryboxes and drop bags for crates and 20mm's designate just for the foodpack. Use the food preference survey to help gather your trips personal boat, cooler and drybox capacity. Submit to this worksheet to PRO.
